2.4 Wholesale Demand Response

Meghan Bibby, AEMO

- New Rule which becomes effective 24 October 2021
- Introduces a new market participant category, a “Demand Response Service Provider” (DRSP)
- Places obligations on DRSPs that replicate those applied to scheduled participants, for example, similar information provision and scheduling obligations
- Sets out a process for having baseline methodologies determined and applied to wholesale demand response units
- Provides for DRSPs to be settled in the wholesale market for the wholesale demand response they have provided

Wholesale Demand Response

- The DRSP
 - Will act as an intermediary for the customer to offer demand response directly to the NEM wholesale market
 - will have a contractual arrangement with the customer where the DRSP will pay the customer for the demand response provided
 - will settle the demand response in the wholesale market
 - will have demand response determined using an approved baseline methodology.

Wholesale Demand Response

- In order to determine how the customer performed against the baseline, the DRSP will likely require access metering information from the customer meter. This will allow the DRSP and customer to settle against customer contracts, and the wholesale spot and futures markets. AEMO envisages a DRSP being allowed to initiate a Provide Meter Data (PMD) transaction for customers where the DRSP has a contractual relationship with the customer that is registered with AEMO in MSATS.
- The NER allows for Third Party B2B Participants who are not also a Distribution Network Service Provider, retailer, Local Retailer, Metering Coordinator, Metering Provider or Metering Data Provider. AEMO approves who is and is not a B2B e-Hub Participant under clause 7.17.2
- DRSP role to be added to Section 5 of the B2B Guide which specifies typically which roles use which transactions and Section 6.6.1(a) which specifies who uses the Provide Meter Data communication.
